Since the closure of The Country Store and PO at the end of 2008 The Village Shop Association and Village Hall committee have been working together on the **Illesington Community Project** to provide a Village Shop and New Room at the Village Hall.

**The Shop**, owned by you, will provide the products and services you want with surplus funds from shop trading going back to the community. **The New Room** will allow current users to expand their activities and encourage other activities. Together we hope these new facilities will create a **Focal Point** for the village.

We have Planning Permission so all we need now are funds! It is estimated the project will cost £200,000. Much of this can be raised through various grants but between 10–20% needs to come from the community as a demonstration of support and commitment.
